Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

The NationsUniversity mission is building authentic faith and training Christian leaders around the world through affordable, accessible higher education, utilizing distance learning.

NationsUniversity conducts numerous statistical analyses in its ongoing efforts to assure quality programs. Per DEAC requirements, two key pi of data are provided to the public: graduation rates and retention rates. Because NationsUniversity uses rolling enrollment and an asynchrono self-paced model, these numbers can be challenging to calculate. However, data presented below by program accurately reflects the student outcomes.

In addition, NationsUniversity assesses overall student satisfaction. This satisfaction is assessed with three questions:

- 1. Did you meet your educational goals that you had when you started at NationsUniversity?
- 2. Would you recommend these studies to a friend?
- 3. All things considered, were you satisfied with you studies at NationsUniversity?

Aggregated Institutional Data on Student Achievement

Certificate in Biblical Studies (21-credit program):

Completion Rate: 58.6%

Admitted Retention Rate: 96.55% (Students still studying who met all admission criteria.)

Bachelor of Religious Studies (120-credit program):

Graduation Rate: 53.85%

Admitted Retention Rate: 76.92%

Graduate Certificate in Biblical Studies (15-credit, post-bac program):

Completion Rate: 68.6%

Admitted Retention Rate: 91.67%

Master of Theological Studies (36-credit program):

Graduation Rate: 40.5%

Admitted Retention Rate: 89.19%

Master of Divinity did not have a sufficient size cohort for calculations.

93.94% of graduates achieved their educational goals upon completing their program.

96.97% of graduate would recommend NationsUniversity to a friend.
